



REQUIREMENTS FOR CANADIAN TRAVEL

Beginning August 1, 2024 the US Department of Agriculture and Centers for Disease Control are implementing new requirements for dogs entering the United States. These changes specifically will affect GAVC clients who are taking their dogs over the Canadian land border. Please read and understand these requirements before planning a trip!

REQUIREMENTS

- The dog must be 6 months old
- The dog must have an ISO-compatible microchip implanted (\$85)
- The dog must have a current Rabies vaccine.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- 1) CDC Import Form (<https://bit.ly/3Wq83tx>)
 - This import form is filled out by the owner and must include uploaded pictures of the dog as well as the microchip number.
 - There is no fee for the CDC import form

Paper copies of this forms and your dog's rabies certificate are highly recommended when crossing the border.

(NOTE: The Certificate of US-Issued Rabies Vaccination form requirement has been CANCELLED.)
